Libraries

Many Italian libraries have manuscript and archival collections. Check Kristeller's *Iter Italicum* for descriptions/locations of medieval and Renaissance mss., and the SBN and individual library websites for descriptions of fonds. Many of the resources in the previous section also contain information on libraries.

Libraries in Italy also have rich collections of rare books, newspapers and journals, ephemera, as well as monographs.

Unfortunately, the online catalogs to Italy's libraries are not complete, and only contain relatively recent acquisitions (usually from the 1980s-present). Thus, the print catalogs (BNI, CUBI) are still very useful. The library websites have lots of other useful information, however, and should not be overlooked.
