The Blue Books for various countries contain statistics, facts on colonial employees, agriculture, education, transport, imports and exports, criminal statistics, hospitals, health, laws passed, expenditures and revenue, etc. The 1919 Nigeria Blue Book, for example, reveals that over 208,000 boys were enrolled in Northern Nigerian schools, while no girls were enrolled. However, over 4,000 girls were enrolled in Southern Nigerian schools. The Blue Books also give the name, date appointed, and salary of colonial officials.

To find Stanford's holdings of Blue Books in Socrates –

1. In **SOCRATES**, Use the **Combined Search**
2. For Author, put in the Country. For title put in blue book

1. Find **Melvyl University of California's Web-based catalog**

2. Once in Melvyl, Choose **Periodical Titles**.

Do Not choose Melvyl Catalog.

Blue Books are published annually so they are periodicals and they will not be in the UC's regular online catalog.

UCB has, for example, 45 years (1901/02-1945) on microfilm of Uganda Blue Books, whereas Stanford has 1914-1928 in print form.

3. Select the **Power Search**.

4. **Select Corporate Author**. Put in the Country name, Uganda, Nigeria, etc.

5. For the second Search, type, select **Exact Periodical Title**. Put in blue book

6. **Limit Location to U.C. Berkeley** but it may still show you Stanford holdings first.

You then have to click on UCB to get their holdings.

Then click on Submit Search.

Note the results will include Stanford holdings sometimes as well as the UC libraries.

BRITISH COMMAND PAPERS

In footnotes or bibliographies you may come across references to publications with the words Cd., C.1234, Cmd. 1234. These are Command Papers, reports of inquiries, department annual reports, etc. presented to the British Parliament.

Hoover Library and Green Library have some individually cataloged.

In addition, **Green Library (Stanford University Libraries)** has **almost all** of the Command Papers in print and on microfiche. They are among the British Parliamentary papers in Green Library and these are not individually cataloged. You can find them through indexes.

The print collection of command papers prior to 1900 is in SAL; you need to page these through the Special Collections Circulation Desk. However you may find it easier to use the microfiche version of the pre 1900 command papers. Command papers published after that date are in Green stacks.

Hint: Use general terms in searching. If words are too specific, you may get nothing. Also you may have to try several different words alone. However if you have an exact citation, you can be more specific.

[Note. The indexes may occasionally cite a document which is supposed to contain information for a geographic area (Lagos for example). However when you look at the document (may be on fiche), you find that a report for that area was not received and is thus not available. An example is Return of the rates [for Lagos] 1871 (510) XLVIII.701

British Colonial Office and Foreign Office Documents in Microfilm and Print

The confidential prints contain letters, telegrams, despatches, speeches, memos, intelligence reports, bills, decrees printed for distribution within the British government offices, embassies, consulates, etc. A print can be from 1 to 500 pages. Each has a number but sometimes the same number was given to two or three different documents.

The confidential print contain only those items selected for circulation internally.
