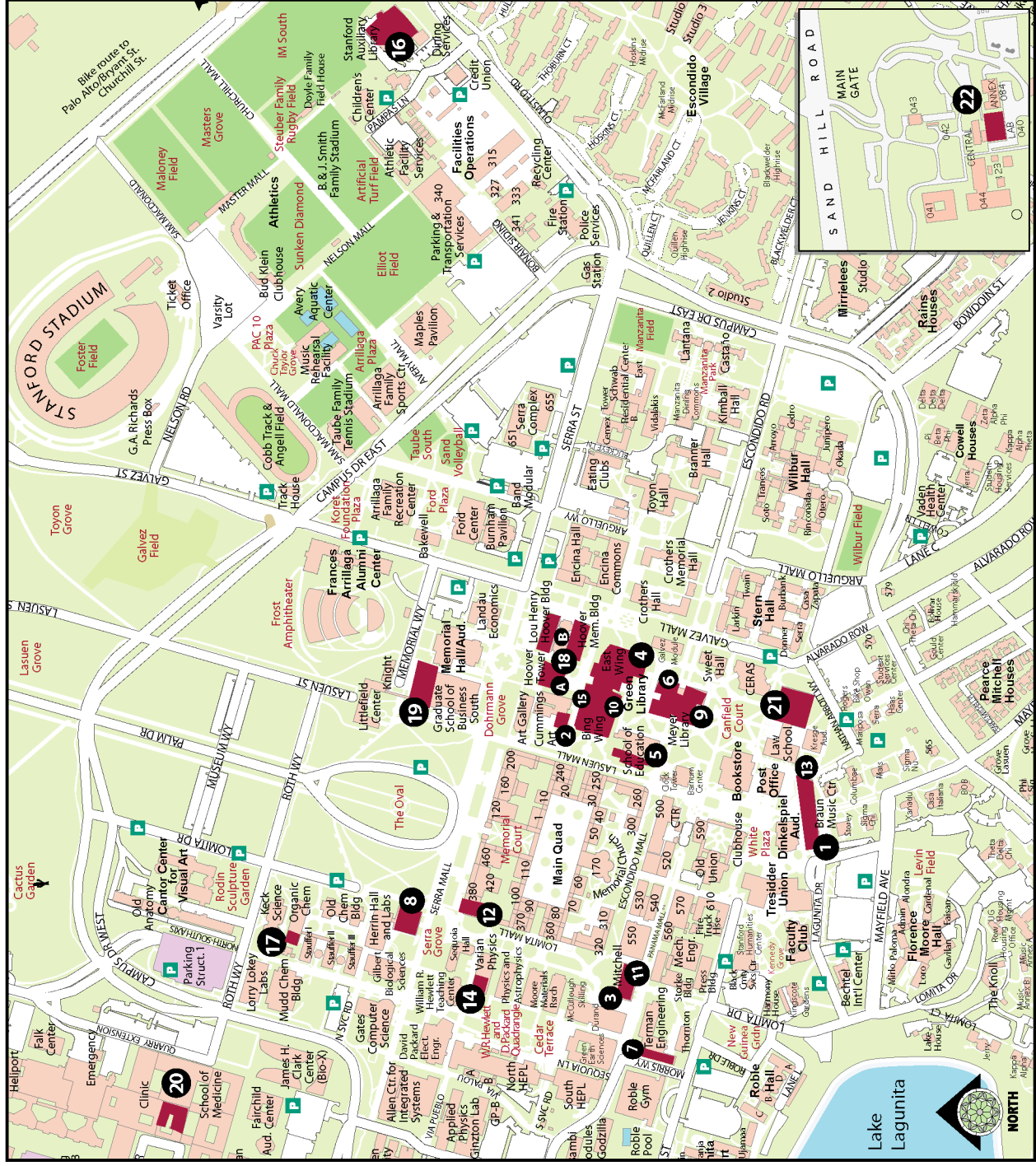

### Archive of Recorded Sound (1)

Archives over 280,000 recordings, ranging from popular music to public addresses.

### Art and Architecture Library (2)

Non-circulating collection of art history and architectural history.

### Branner Earth Sciences Library (3)

Collection contains printed materials, online references and images. GIS workstations and programs available for faculty, students and staff.

### Cecil H. Green Library (4)

Holds the majority of research collections in the humanities and social sciences, as well as general reference materials and periodicals.

### Cubberley Education Library (5)

Wide range of education books, journals, and online materials, plus historic and current textbooks, historic reports and college catalogs.

### East Asia Library (6)

Comprehensive collection of serials, government documents and periodicals.
